In the matter of the Claim for Pension of John
 Lehigh N^o 264,639

Personally came before me Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas
 of Armstrong County, John Lehigh above named claimant who
 being duly sworn says that. He cannot prove time place and circum-
 stance of contracting disease by a commissioned officer for the
 reason that they are either dead or their whereabouts are unknown
 to him and he cannot find where they are. That he cannot
 prove physical condition before he entered or enlisted or at time
 of enlistment by a physician as he was a perfectly sound
 man and never employed a physician prior to enlistment
 that he has any recollection of.

That in returning from the army on or about the 23^d of April 1863
 the physician who treated him first was Dr Stephenson who
 treated him for gonorrhea for some three or four years, and died
 the next physician who treated him was Dr Wm Beatty in Latona
 across the river from Oil City Pa where the claimant was then
 living who treated him for about five years for the gonorrhea. But
 he has left and gone this claimant knows not where.

The next who treated him was Drs Campbell & Dennis who
 lived in Martinsburg Butter Co, Pa who treated him until the
 Spring of 1868 That Drs Campbell & Dennis have
 removed from Martinsburg Pa and have gone
 west this claimant knows not where and has
