Personally came William
 F. Blugh a credible witness who on oath says
 that John Blugh was at date of his enlistment
 in Sept 1862 a man of sound physical health and
 free from disease and especially free from Chron-
 ic Bronchitis Lumbago and Chronic Gastric
 Catarrh or any disease whatever affecting his throat
 chest back or stomach and he believes that had
 he been at all diseased his means of knowledge
 was such that had he been at all diseased he
 would have known of it that the first time
 he saw him after discharge was in the winter
 of 1866 or 1867 and he was then suffering from
 Chronic Bronchitis Lumbago and Gastric
 Catarrh was totally disabled from labor by
 said diseases for several months and has
 suffered continually each year since from
 said diseases and has each year since been dis-
 abled from manual labor by Chronic Bronchi-
 tis Lumbago and Gastric Catarrh at least
 one half if not more but frequently so dis-
 abled that he had to stop work but he
 cannot recollect the doctor His means of
 knowledge of the above facts is that he is the
 brother of said John Blugh and worked with him
 prior to enlistment and immediately prior thereto
 that he saw him for the first in winter of 1866 or 7
