 since 1864 by said Chronic Bronchitis Lum-  
 bago and Chronic Gastric Catarrh at least  
 one half if not more from manual labor  
 His means of knowledge of the above facts  
 is that he was intimately acquainted with said  
 John Blugh at and for several years be-  
 fore enlistment and knows personally that  
 he was free from above diseases and they  
 worked together and had claimant been at all
