Personally came John Blugh
 who on oath says that while a member
 of Co "L" 14th P.V. Cavalry at Harper's Ferry
 Va on about the last of February A.D. 1863 he
 had an attack of jaundice and his Stomach and
 Liver became diseased and he became afflicted
 with what the physicians called Curbage and
 his spine was so affected by it that he could
 scarcely get about. He also suffers from what
 the physicians called Bronchitis which affected his
 throat badly and caused the loss of speech for
 some time that he was shortly after sent
 to the hospital at Harper's Ferry Va where he was
 treated for said diseases that he was also treated
 by Dr Wynne Key Surgeon - That upon his discharge
 he was suffering from said diseases and has
 suffered from them continually each year since

That he is not able to furnish the evidence of
 any Commissioned Officer for the reason that some
 of them he is informed are dead and others he cannot
 find although he has diligently inquired and attempted
 to find them. The only Medical witness he is able
 to furnish of said diseases while in the service is
 that of Dr Wynne now on file - As to affidavits
 of comrades see that of Bellas & Brydger on file of
 that of Francis A. Reges enclosed - He is not
 able to furnish the same as to his health
