 rejection of his claim that he has suf-
 fered continually each year since
 discharge by reason of diseases which
 he contracted in the Army that he has
 furnished proof of contracting said
 diseases in the service and of being
 free from said diseases at enlistment
 and of suffering continually since from
 said diseases and being disabled
 from manual labor each year
 by them - that his claim was rejected
 according to the notice he received for the reason
 that he had Bronchitis at enlistment and has
 not been disabled since discharge by fam-
 die - He also claims pension by reason
 (see papers filed) of Lumbago and
 Gastric Catarrh

That the Department refused to open his
 claim upon his appeal Applicant asks
 that his appeal of May 2nd 1882 be
 either allowed or that he be allowed
