I am personally acquainted with the above
 Claimant he is my Brother, & I was a member of
 Co. M. Same Regiment & while in camp at
 Harper's ferry he was taken to Hospital on Bolivar
 Heights & had a very severe attack of jaundice
 this was about Feb 1863. I went different
 times to Hospital, to see him during two sicknesses
 & he was very poorly, & some time after
 he returned to duty don't remember how
 long; he lost his voice & after that our
 Regiment was divided & I did not see
 him if I remember till after he was discharged
 also I remember of him being crippled
 in the Back, & further would say before
 entering the army he was a hearty
 & sound man to the best of my knowledge
 & during the last ten years I know
 very little about him not having seen
 him to my knowledge for 8 or 9 years from
 the present time. I have no interest in this
 case
