Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

State of Penn, County of Amherst, SS:

On this 21 day of Sept, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety sum personally appeared before me, a justice of the peace within and for the County and State aforesaid John Clough, aged 67 years, a resident of the Leechburg of Pa, county of Amherst State of Pa, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner

of the United States, Certificate No. 843745 enrolled at the Leechburg Pension Agency

at the rate of 5.00 dollars per month, by reason of disability from partial inability
