Dear Madam:

This will acknowledge receipt of your communication of July 16, 1941, requesting information relative to your entitlement to pension as child of the above named Civil War veteran.

You are informed that you could have no title to pension under the existing Service Acts for the reason that you are over sixteen years of age.

In order for the child of a Civil War veteran to have title to pension under the General Law, it is necessary to show, among other things, that such child had not attained the age of sixteen years at the date of the veteran's death and that the disease or injury which cause the veteran's death was incurred in line of duty during his service in the Civil War.

It is not indicated from the evidence of record in this case that you could have title to pension under the above mentioned law.

All communications relative to this case should bear the name of the veteran and refer to the number WC-596,708.
